## Proposed amendment to Constitutional Rule 3.7

## The current Constitutional rule 3.7 reads:

The Club may refuse membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute, or, in the case of a swimmer, being unable to achieve the entry standards as laid down and provided by the club to the applicant for membership.

## The proposed amendment to rule 3.7 is as follows:

On Line 2 following the word "or", insert the following:

"Likely to create Disharmony in the Club or" then continue as written.

## The amended rule 3.7 would then read:

The Club may refuse membership only for good and sufficient cause, such as conduct or character likely to bring the Club or sport into disrepute, or likely to create Disharmony in the Club, or in the case of a swimmer, being unable to achieve the entry standards as laid down and provided by the club to the applicant for membership.

The reason for this proposal is on the advice of a representative of Swim England / ASA.
