

## **Warriors of Warrington Club Championships**

### **Promoter's Conditions**

The competition will be held under ASA Laws and ASA Technical Rules of Swimming and is licensed by the ASA at Level 4, Licence Number – 4NW192518. It is open to all Active System registered swimming members of Warriors of Warrington Swimming Club.

Competitors who hold a disability classification should declare this on the entry form. Certificates of Disability and Disability Classification Numbers should be presented to the referee prior to the start of the gala. Failure to do so may render the swimmer liable for disqualification for non-compliance with the rules for a particular stroke.

Pool                                         8 lane, deck level, 25 metre with anti-wave lane ropes.

Age Groups                                8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15, 16, 17/o.  
Age as at 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2019,

**Younger club swimmers under the age of 8 years will be permitted to enter events appropriate to their age group, but please note that these events will not be licensed and the times achieved will not be submitted to the rankings database.**

The choice of events for each age group is detailed on the entry form. The Novice programme is offered to swimmers aged 10 and under who are in Junior Development, Junior 1, Junior 2 or C Squad only. It will cater primarily for new swimmers (defined as those who have joined the club in the last six months). 25m times achieved are not permitted to be entered onto the rankings database.

Events                                      25 Free, Back, Fly, Breast (for Novice swimmers only)  
50 Free, Back, Fly, Breast  
100 Free, Back, Fly, Breast (for swimmers aged 11+ only)  
200 Free, Back, Fly, Breast  
400 Free (for swimmers aged 11+ only)  
100 or 200 Individual Medley (for swimmers aged 10 or under)  
200 or 400 Individual Medley (for swimmers aged 11+)

The one start rule will apply and over the top starts will be used. Events will be swum as integrated age groups with seeding by submitted times.

Medals/Awards                            Medals will be presented to the top 3 swimmers in each age group. Swimmers with disabilities will be included within the results for their age group. All events are heat declared winners. Swimmers will also swim for FINA points with the strongest combination of events being decided by the computer. The results for classified

swimmers with disabilities will be scored using the British Swimming Disability Points system.

The top 6 swimmers in each age group will be presented with awards at the Club's presentation evening.

Entry Times	There are no lower or upper limit times for this gala. Please enter your fastest Ranked times against the events you wish to swim, following the guidelines for each age group on the attached entry form. If you do not have a time for a particular event, please enter NT against the relevant event on the attached entry form. Please remember that once submitted, entries cannot be changed and poolside entries will not be permitted.
Closing Date	Midnight Friday 6 <sup>th</sup> September 2019
Entries/Withdrawals	Entries will be done via the Active Portal The gala will run cardless with a withdrawal system in operation. Any swimmer wishing to withdraw from an event must follow the withdrawal procedures which will be posted on the club website.
Data Protection	Entries for this meet will be held on computer and results will be submitted to the ASA Rankings Service. Under the General Data Protection Regulations 2018, permission to hold personal data will be deemed to have been given by submission of an entry.
Shop	The Warriors Swim Shop will be available throughout the meet.
Admission	Spectator admission will be £3.00 per adult per session with children under 16 admitted free. Programme's will be available on the day, priced at £2, this will cover all sessions. All results will be available on Meet Mobile and the Live Results link on the website homepage.
Security	You are advised not to leave any clothing or other articles unattended as neither the Promoters nor the Pool Management can accept responsibility for loss or damage.
Photography	There may be an official photographer at the meet and by entering the meet you accept that your Swimmer may be photographed. Photographs will be offered for sale at the meet and on-line. Access to on-line event photography is controlled via the use of a log-in ID and password.  <b>If you do not want your swimmer to be photographed under any circumstances please inform the Promoter before the meet begins.</b>
Disputes	The Referee's decision will be final on all matters relating to Swimming and Swimmer discipline.
