Promoters Conditions

Meet Level

The meet is licensed at level 3 and shall be run under Swim England Laws and Technical Rules and the promoters conditions. The competition is open to all swimmers who are at least 9 years old on the final day of the meet and who are registered competitive members of the Swim England (Cat 2)

Age Groups

The Age Groups will be 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, and 14/over. Age as at midnight on 27 October 2019.

Pool

The competition shall be held in an 8 lane 25m pool with anti wave lane ropes. Electronic timing shall be in operation.

Events and Entries

Events are 50m, 100m, 200m all strokes, 100m I.M. and 200m I.M. (All ages)

Entries to be submitted electronically using the Sportsystem software. Information pack will be available on the club website www.blackpoolaquatics.org

Entries shall be accepted on a first come first served basis from Monday 9 September 2019 up to and including the closing date, Wednesday 9 October 2019 or when the gala capacity has been reached whichever occurs first.

Accepted entries will be posted on the club website after the meet has closed. A refund will be given to competitors whose entry is denied where this condition has been exercised.

Disability Swimmers

Classified disability swimmers are permitted to enter without the requirement of having achieved a consideration time.

Fees and Payment

The entry fee shall be £4.75 per event.

Weekend Coaches Passes are £15 per coach (for entry, programme, heat start lists, light lunch and poolside refreshments). Coaches must be a member of the club competing, hold a coaches pass issued by Blackpool Aquatics ASC and comply with the relevant Swim England Child Safeguarding Procedures and have a valid DBS certificate.

Payment for entries and coaches passes must be made by a single cheque to Blackpool Aquatics ASC, or by transfer to the club bank account, details on summary entry form.

Spectator entry shall be by colour coded wristbands. Entry fees £5 per day, £3 per session.

The promoter reserves the right to refuse admission to any spectator, coach or swimmer.

The Competition

Over the top starts may be in operation (this may include backstroke).

The heats shall be swum all ages seeded together.

Each event will be on "Heat Declared Winner" basis.

Spot prizes will be awarded to the winner of randomly selected heats (regardless of any disqualifications).

Awards

The following shall apply.

Awards will be presented to the top three swimmers in each event and each age group.

Swimmers who at this meet swim faster than the upper limit consideration time by more than 1 second (50m), 2 seconds (100m) and 3 seconds (200m) will be excluded from the awards. They will receive a speeding ticket in recognition of their efforts. The Upper limit times, with the allowance added, will be published in the programme.

Data Protection

Meet entries shall be managed on a computer. Your consent to the holding of personal information for the purposes of the Meet shall be treated as being given by the submission of your entries, as shall your consent for such details to be published both during and after the meet.

Consideration Times

There are consideration times (Lower Limit and Upper Limit) for this Meet. Submitted times MUST be equal to or faster than the lower limit time AND slower than the upper limit time. Please submit 25m pool times. The requirement of having achieved a consideration time relies significantly on the integrity of coaches, swimmers and parents to submit correct truthful information. No refunds for mistakes. Random checks will be made against the current ASA rankings database for times achieved since October 2018.

Photography

No photography is permitted in the pool hall. No mobile phones will be permitted on poolside.

Strobe

Administration of the Meet

There will be two sessions per day.

Withdrawals must be made on an official withdrawal form to be submitted at least 1 hour before the start of the session, or by text to mobile number 07508 427444 from Thursday 24 October 2019.

Competitors are responsible for presenting themselves to the clerks of the course in the Sports Hall one event prior to the one in which they are competing. It is the swimmers responsibility to be at the start in time for their race.

Results will be published in the coaches' room, spectator area and poolside. Full copies of results and club performance summaries will be e mailed to each competing club after the conclusion of the meet.

Conditions not covered in these competition rules shall be dealt with in accordance with the laws of the sport and at the discretion of the promoter.
